**IN-SERVICE INSPECTION TRAINING  
NBIC PARTS 2 (Inspection) and Part 3 (Repairs)**

The Licensing and Inspections Branch of Corrections, Public Safety and Policing will be hosting a training session on the National Board Inspection Code (NBIC) in Regina on January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

This in-service inspection training session will be delivered by the National Board of Boiler and Pressure Vessel Inspectors and will focus on Part 2 (Inspections) and Part 3 (Repairs and Alterations) of the 2007 Code edition.

As the *Boiler and Pressure Vessel Regulations* currently adopt the NBIC for installation, repairs, and alterations of boilers and pressure vessels within Saskatchewan, attendance at this session may be of interest to those within your organization who are responsible for this type of work.
